The award shall consist of a plaque and a check of \$1,000.

NOMINATIONS

Rules and Eligibility

Nominees for the Young Investigator Award can come from university, government or companies using MBE technology from anywhere in the world. They must have made significant contributions to the science and technology of MBE or enabled by MBE by the age of 40 and show promise of future leadership in the field. The awardee should be less than 40 at least sometime in the year of the award. The awardee should have presented the cited work at one or more NAMBE conferences.

Administration

The NAMBE Advisory Board will manage the Young Investigator Award. It will be responsible for soliciting and evaluating the nominations and for final selection of the award recipient.
